

This method of tax avoidance is very straightforward:

Of the monies I received from my clients I declare all the monies due to a foreign patent attorneys as a tax-deductible expense, but never actually remit these monies to the foreign patent attorneys. Those monies I transfer into my Family Trust. This Trust then trades as a separate entity (Wobbegong Technology Information Pty. Ltd. Again, these unpaid overheads are also declared as tax-deductible expenses.
